♣ A social structure made of individuals (or organizations) called "nodes," which are tied (connected) by one or more specific types of interdependency, such as

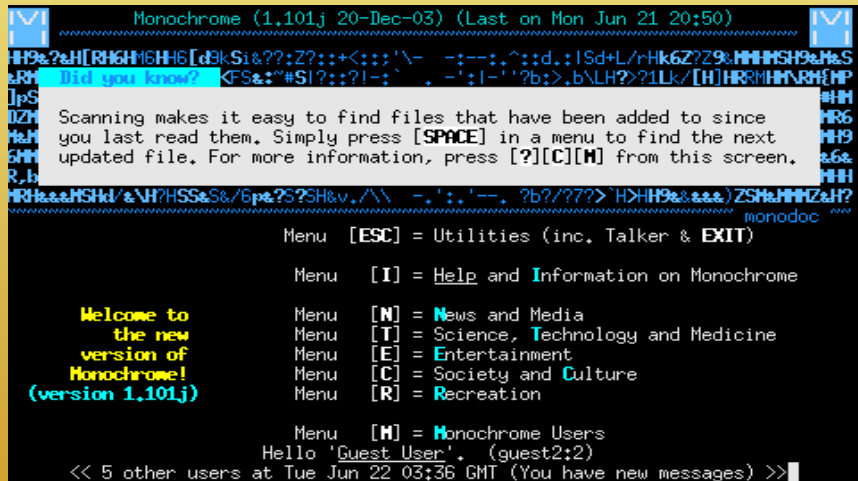
- ☐ Friendship

- ☐ Sexual relationships, or
- ☐ Relationships of beliefs, knowledge or prestige

- ⚠ Be careful what you say!
- ⚠ Opportunities for identity theft and fraud
- ⚠ Easier for you to be stalked and harassed online
- ⚠ Opportunities for predators

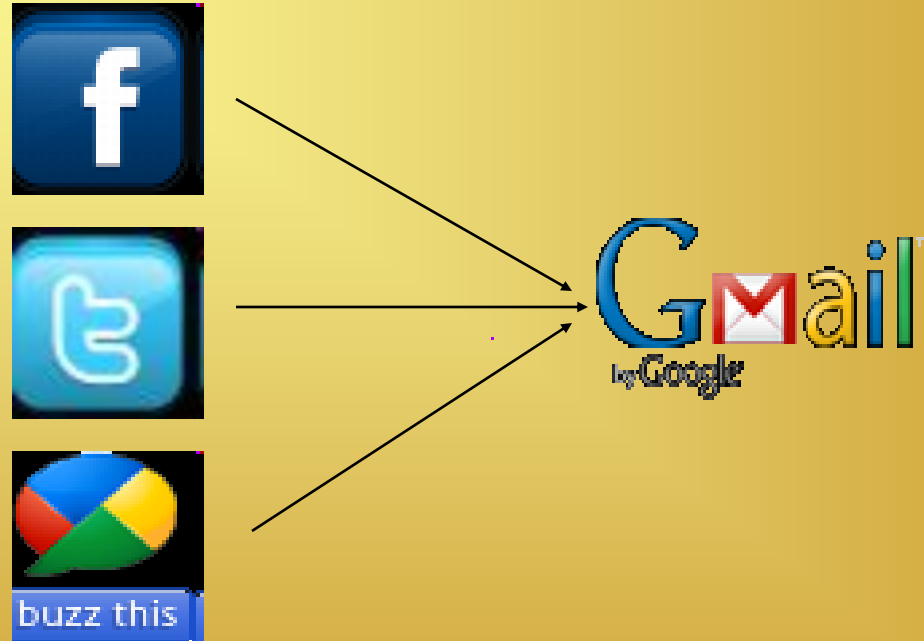
## *Social Network Integration (2)*

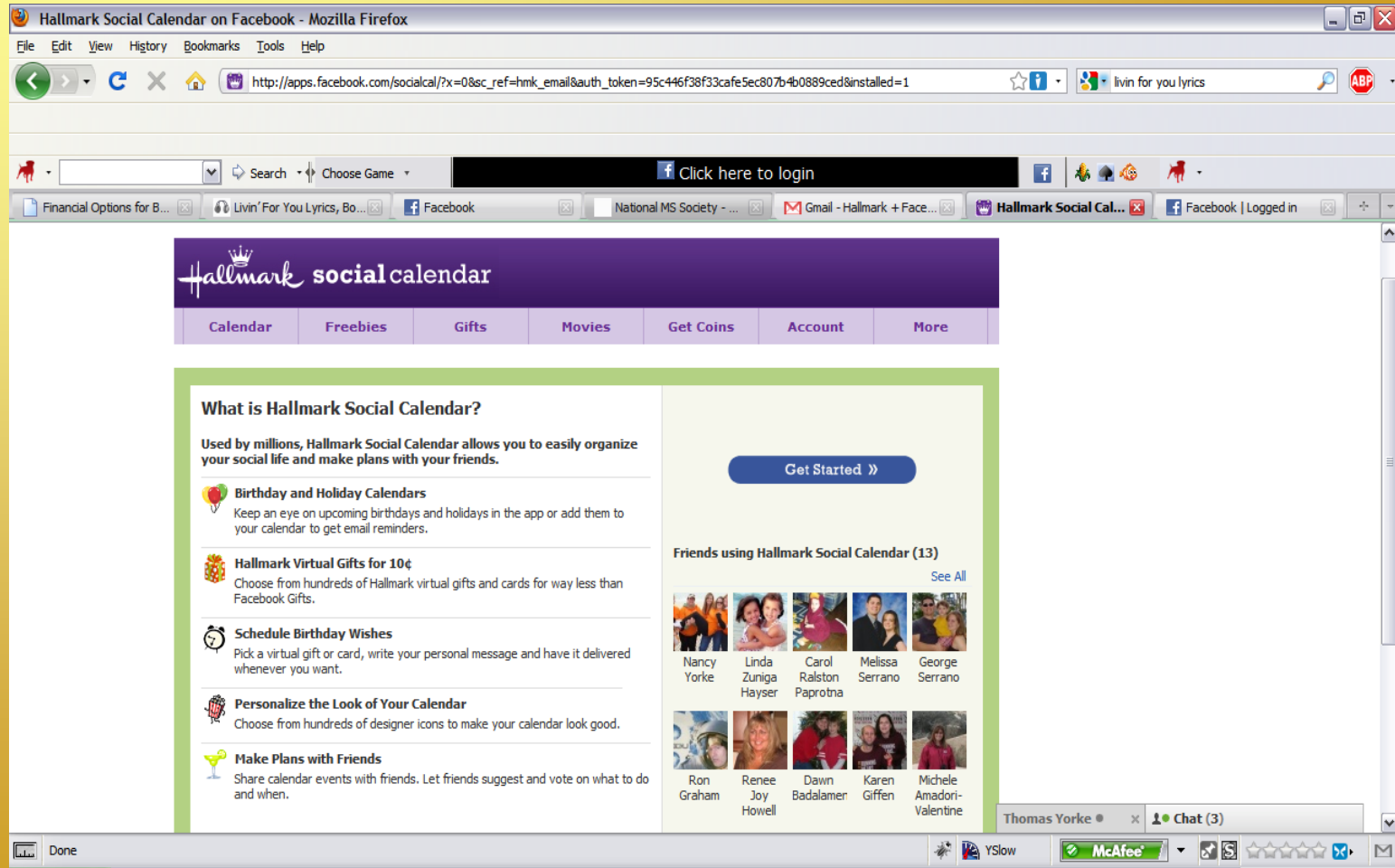

```
Twitter twitter = new Twitter();
```
